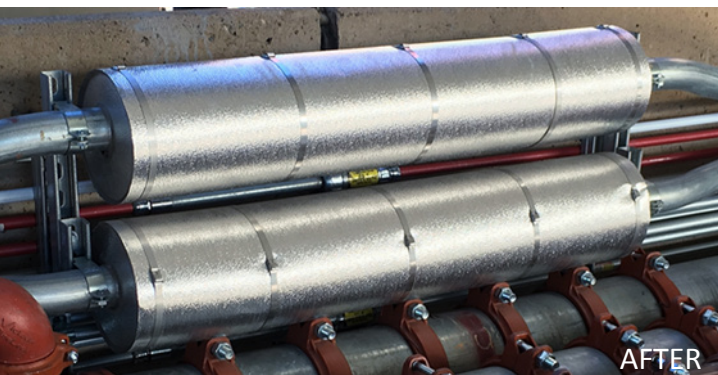
Firestopping

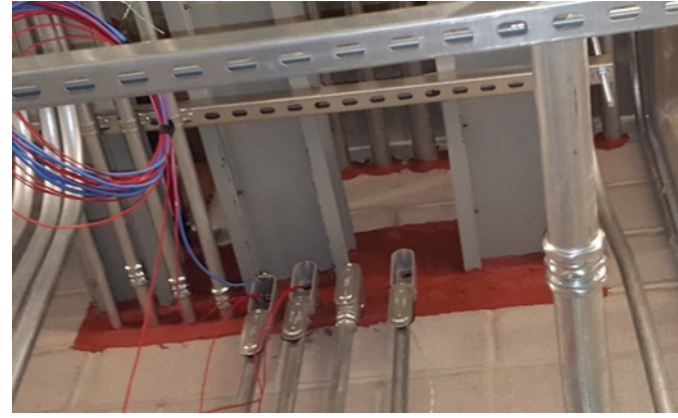
